Headteacher update:

This afternoon I was able to speak to Year 2 parents at the first of our KS1 to KS2 transition meetings from a new perspective. In previous years I have 'tag-teamed' with Mr Barber or Mr Parr, each of us adding our own school input. Being able to talk about our joined-up curriculum approach and knowing how things work in both schools and give parents reassurance about this transition, was a great example of the positive impact this year's changes will have.
