

English (C&L)

Extend vocabulary – topic words.

Writing – Labeling diagrams, making own information texts, writing instructions, poetry and story writing and developing sentences.

Speaking & Listening/ drama – Role-play, explore ideas & situations; develop awareness of the listener; listen to stories & poems, reading work aloud to their peers.

Reading – Read and develop understanding of instructions, information & stories: individually, in small groups & as part of a whole class. Focus on comprehension of texts.

Phonics – Using and applying sounds taught. Learn different pronunciations for sounds, syllables, compound words and pre-fixes and suffixes.

Spelling – Recognise common spelling patterns and apply simple spelling rules, spell simple words including common and tricky words taught.
