Term 3 Spending The above £3,000 has enabled us to continue to pledge to assist the school with the calm playground, the refurbishment of two classrooms and a whole-school arts & drama workshop with Travelling Light. This is an opportunity for all children to benefit from and express themselves at a time when they may be struggling with the many challenges posed by Covid-19.

We Need You! FHIS is a small but committed group of volunteers who collectively run the PTA. We are looking for someone to learn the ropes and take on the role as one of two Treasurers. Also, in July, the current Secretary and Chair will move on and the workload for

the existing Committee will increase beyond their capacity resulting in the PTA being unable


