Dear Parent/Carer,

We're aware that children are required to be in more contained groups at home and school which makes friendship niggles all the more likely; we're reminding children of our school values of respect and inclusion as well as the need to be

kind and if they are struggling with feelings to share them.

I hope that you all have a restful weekend and are able to begin to make plans with friends and family following the next phase of lockdown.
