Dear Parent/Carer,

It has been a dramatic week! Not only because the weather kept us on our toes, but due to the final rehearsals and recording of the Year 1 play. From what I have seen, we are in for a real treat. I am impressed with the commitment of the Year 1 children in the scenery making as well as learning of songs and lines. Great work!

Teachers have also been stopping me to share their pride in some wonderful writing this week. Reception have been retelling Jack and the Beanstalk; showing Stickability Tortoise skills to write their first story. In Year 2 children have been using their senses to help evoke descriptive language in their retelling of the Tin Forest. We have been flabbergasted by the sophisticated vocabulary used.

Looking ahead to our final week of term and heading to the Bank Holiday break, I would like to remind parents that we are following our school and local; authority attendance policy now that the school is fully open and will not be able to authorise any term-time holidays.

After the break, we look forward to being able to reduce some of our Covid measures (government advice dependent) and will start to introduce some outside mixing at playtime and lunchtime. We feel that this will enable our children to prepare for the transition back in September where we anticipate having less restriction in place, as well as giving them an opportunity to make wider relationships within the school. Reception children will be particularly keen to spread into the main playground as this is a rite of passage!

Looking even further ahead, we will be having some staff changes in September due to the retirement of Mrs Browne, Mrs Keefe and Mrs Ashcroft. All have been with Henleaze Infant School for an extraordinary length of time (nearly 70 years between them!) and have contributed to the lives of hundreds of children and families. They will be greatly missed, but leave their teams in a great place

to welcome new staff. Both internal and external recruitment has been taking place throughout this term and we are excited about the next chapter to come. In Term 6 I will update children and parents about teachers and teaching assistants for next year. We have lots of plans to put in place first, so please be patient and bear with us.


