



Dear Parent/Carer,

This week we have continued with our planning for the final summer term including Year 2 transition to junior schools, new Reception children visiting as well as current Reception and Year 1 children 'shuffling up' to new classes. In the dates section of this newsletter I have added some key events; the 'shuffle up' week as well as an invitation for parents to come into classrooms for a 'learning share'. We also hope to invite parents for a Year 2 Leavers event, but need to leave plans flexible to enable us to follow the latest guidance. Look out for exact timings and plans next term.

We will be preparing children for the changes in September as part of our curriculum throughout Term 6. As part of this we will have a whole-school project using the text Journey (as we did last year) to elicit children's thoughts and support them to feel excited about the transition. One practical change is our decision to allow the children to mix outdoors as described in last week's newsletter. We are still required to have staggered start and end times to the day, so this will be a mixing of half the school only.

As well as our plans for transition, we will be continuing with our recovery curriculum progression throughout Term 6, with final teacher assessments in weeks 3 and 4, which will be published in school reports in the penultimate week of term. Teachers will be updating blogs with plans and news of what has been happening in classes each week.
