



Dear Parent/Carer,

The exciting news for the children this week is that we have over 50 newts in our pond! Mrs Thoburn (our in-house marine Biologist) tells us that they are back to mate, so hopefully we'll have a healthy number again next year.

In other learning, there has been some high-quality, sustained writing in Year 2, with children re-writing Owl Babies carefully selecting ambitious word choices and sentence types to produce a well-edited story. We are really proud of their creativity and perseverance. In the play time, year 2 have been showing off their gymnastics skills, making the most of the artificial grass as a space to cartwheel, crab and tumble.

Year 1 have been busy preparing for the Litter Muncher production, but alongside this in an RE session, have been taking time to slow down and be reflective about the world around them, using sense to explore and investigate.

Reception have enjoyed spreading out across the whole Reception patio mixing with friends from the other classes and getting creative with resources funded by FHIS in the music corner. They have also been working in pairs in their maths time; reading Noah's Ark and counting in 2s, which will progress into learning about coins and multiplication in KS1.

Members of the SLT Inclusion Team were involved in a monitoring day with our Bristol Education partner on Tuesday. The focus was on the development in provision for our pupils with SEND as this has been a school priority over the past academic year. We observed some wonderful examples of the strong relationships adults and children have during class sessions and interventions. Our BEP commented on how enthusiastic and engaged the children were and

noted the obvious thought and skill put towards provision for our more vulnerable learners. Over the next week I will be sending home a short survey to parents of children on the SEN register to get their feedback to help us continue this good progress.
