Thank you to Skyboat Café who hosted our first Mother's Day Wine Tasting Event for FHIS raising £400. The FHIS Community Easter Egg Trail raised £140 for FHIS. A further £140 raised was donated to Feeding Bristol providing lunches for 85 children over the Easter holidays. More recently, 299 orders of Father's Day Mugs are set to raise over £550. A huge thanks go to Karen, Emily, Andrea, Lorna, Amanda & Vilma for their help. Collectively, you have helped to raise over £10,500 so far this academic year which is an outstanding achievement in view of lockdown and the



inability to hold in-person events such as the 2020 Fireworks display or the 2021 May Fair. A big thank you to everyone for your support. We would be grateful for your continuing support as we move into the final term.

Spending Update & Term 4 & 5 Spending We are pleased to hear that the new blocks and associated trolleys have finally arrived! It is anticipated that the new library furniture will be in situ by July. At the FHIS Open Meeting on 28th April, attendees voted and FHIS agreed to support the school with the following items; a multi-purpose roleplay house (£1,000), ELLI eBook to support all children with life long learning skills (£500), Resources Budget (£2,500), split between Guided Reading resources (£1,000), Science & Geography resource (£600) and a £100 resource budget

per class. You may have seen the circle of tree stumps that have appeared on the Infant field (running parallel with Park Grove) following Forest School's recent re-location from the Junior School field. This will be our new **Forest School Conservation Area.** A new gated fence, posts for hammocks and storage will provide resources for children & wildlife alike, alongside a mud kitchen and planting area (£1,200). Related to this, we have also pledged to support **School Council's** request for £1,000 for **planters and plants.** FHIS will also provide cooling **Iollies** for the children this Sport's Day, 12th July.



As the children enjoyed their day of enrichment when Travelling Light hosted their whole school drama workshop earlier this month, FHIS have also pledged to support the school with funds of up to £1,700 for a similar drama workshop in 2021/22; £2,000 for the refurbishment of two classrooms summer (2022) & a financial agreement of £1,500 for forest school sessions for new Reception starters. This is only possible with your support. Thank you in what we know have been challenging times.


