Headteacher update:

As this longer than usual term is coming to its final weeks, I am pleased to say the children have continued to illustrate kindness and the positive ethos that we have been focusing on as part of our class and whole school theme of 'Me in my World'. We explicitly teach children about building positive relationships with one another and support them through collaborative learning opportunities and in play. This also involves developing strategies for what to do when things don't work out. We teach children to "speak out" and tell trusted adults if they need help to solve a problem, but that sometimes they have the skills themselves and can solve things by listening to one another's point of view. Next term we continue with a similar theme and welcome the support of parents and carers to reinforce our school message about how to 'get along' with others and what to do if they 'fall out' to enable children to develop independent strategies for building relationships. We will send out information during 'Friendship Week' next term and encourage you to take a look.

Below are some examples of the acts of kindness children engaged in that we have on our school display.

P found A without a friend at lunchtime, so asked her to join their game.

R helped his classmates when they weren't sure what to do on an activity.

S was kind to E when she bumped her eye.

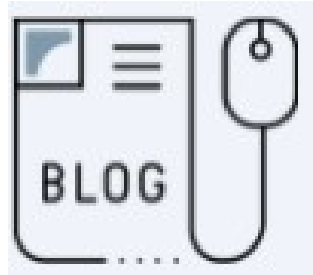
