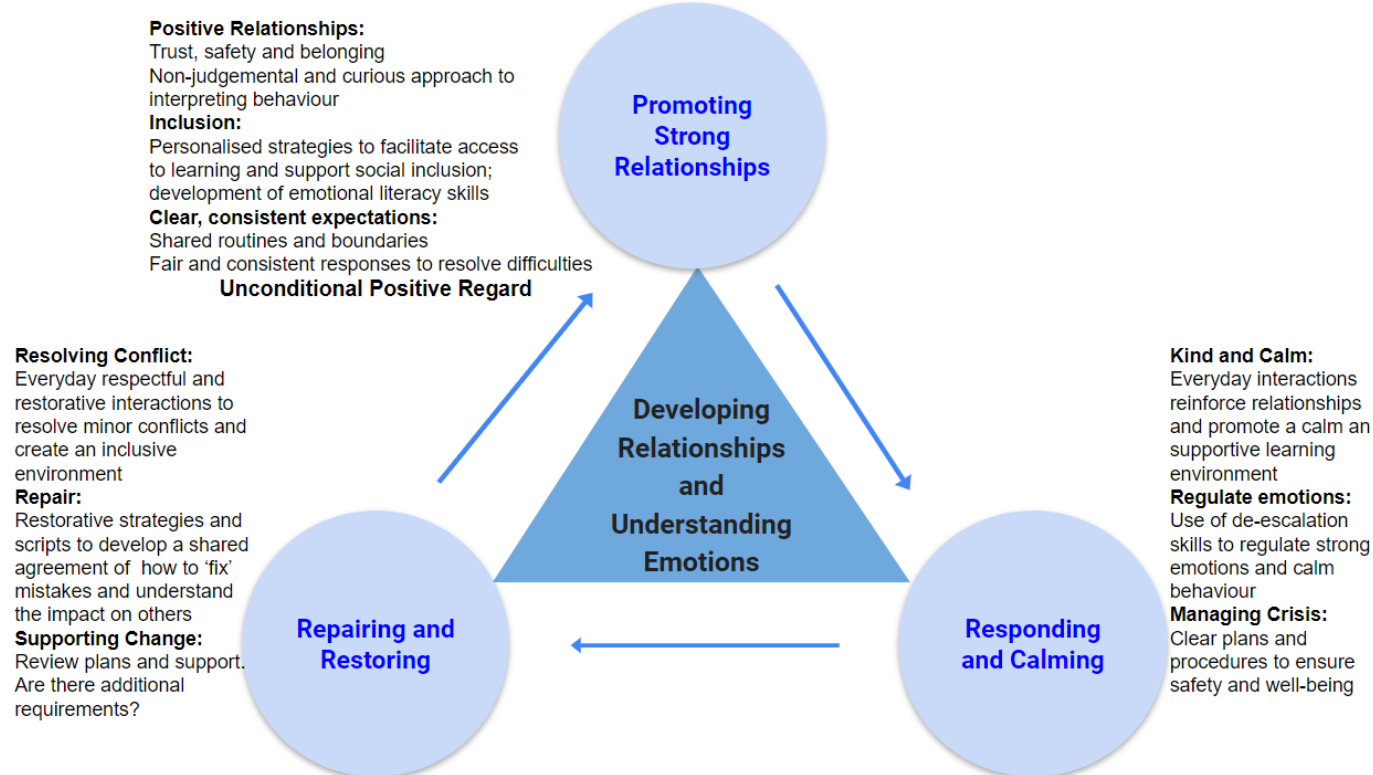


Behaviour Policy Summary for Parents

Rationale: Henleaze Infant School is an attachment aware school where we focus on building positive relationships to create an environment where all children feel secure. We recognise that understanding emotions is the key aspect to interpreting behaviour. Through a non-judgemental and curious approach to behaviour and what it may be communicating, both children and adults are given skills and strategies to manage behaviour and to create an environment that is conducive to learning. We have high expectations for social and learning behaviours to foster a calm and purposeful environment. We teach positive behaviours and use everyday interactions to model our expectations. When children are experiencing difficulties, we seek to understand what emotions negative behaviour is communicating, working with families and where appropriate, with outside agency support.
