### **Important Messages:**

Contagious illnesses:

Following Public Health guidance, there is a 48 hour rule in place whereby pupils and staff who have sickness or diarrhoea must stay away from school for 48 hours after their last episode of D&V. This recognises the risk of infection to others in a setting with close contact with a number of people.

There are other common childhood illnesses which are subject to PHE guidance that schools follow including: chicken pox, impetigo, German measles.
