Pupil Premium Eligibility (Free School Meals)


Pupil Premium funding reaches much further than providing funding for lunches and can be used towards funding your child's in academic or pastoral support. If you are eligible in the year you apply, the school (and next school) receive funding for 6 years from the date it is approved.
