Headteacher update:

It's been a beautiful autumnal week so we've been able to make the most of our great outdoor spaces and really get stuck into to some of the great experiences of this season. Autumn has been marked in school this week with the sounds of voices singing Cauliflowers Fluffy' and 'Harvest Calypso' drifting through the school, conkers being used in classrooms as a learning resource, planning for the Halloween Hunt and Fireworks Extravaganza as well as Year 1 returning from the Arboretum full of excitement of their finds, all proudly wearing Autumn crowns.


