- 4 Communicate with parents about their child's progress and important dates and events.
- 5 Be open and welcoming to parents and encourage them to contribute to their child's learning at home and at school.
- 6 Do our best to ensure that staff, pupils and parents treat each other with good manners, respect, tolerance and fairness.

Parents will:

- 1 In partnership with the school, support their child's learning, including attendance at parents' evenings and curriculum information meetings.
- 2 Ensure regular attendance of their child and inform the school on the first day of illness and on subsequent days thereafter.
- 3 Make sure children are delivered and collected promptly; to ensure a positive transition to and from school. 8.50 start of day, 3.30 end.
- 4 Inform school of any changes that may affect their child's well-being or learning.
- 5 Ensure children attend appropriately dressed following the uniform policy.
- 6 Attend parent evenings' and other events that may be pertinent to their child's progress.
