### Headteacher update:

I hope that you enjoyed discussing your child's progress with class teachers this week. I was really pleased to hear the positive comments as people passed by my office, particularly those that expressed pride in children's hard work and effort. I also heard how impressed some parents are with the level of achievement children reach-it is always amazing to see what progress is made from the start of Reception through Year 1 and into Year 2. In school we have just had our mid-year pupil progress discussions and we all feel immensely proud of every child.

This week the academy conversion stakeholder consultation ended. Thank you to everyone who engaged with governors through either email comments or questions or by attending meetings. Ahead of a planned meeting on the 18th March, governors will review stakeholder input to enable them to make an informed decision as to whether to proceed with the Academy Order (request to the Department for Education to convert). This will determine whether we continue to the next phase that will lead to a final vote in June.
