Headteacher update:

We're really looking forward to the first of the summer terms beginning after Easter. In a change to the past 23 years, there is no longer a statutory requirement for KS1 to sit the KS1 SATs in May. As well as (sensibly) allowing schools to map the Year 2 curriculum over 6 terms rather than 5, we have a bit more flexibility in the school calendar. This year we're using the space to hold our enrichment week during which there will be an amazing array of workshops and activities from cooking to music and dance. Enrichment opportunities also coming up in the Summer terms include the extravaganza that is the Henleaze May Fair where our Year 2s perform their Maypole Dances and the choir showcases their talents and later, in Term 6, will be our annual Sports Day and Year 2 play and with two new additions this year, there will be a sports event and a new music for selected year groups to take part in collaboration with other NW24 schools.
