Headteacher update:

This term, our assembly curriculum has focused on our school value* respect; exploring the concept of respect through various activities and stories. In discussions, students have been encouraged to share their thoughts on what respect means to them and how they can demonstrate it in their daily interactions. These conversations have been instrumental in helping children recognise the importance of listening to others and appreciating diverse perspectives.

We have been thinking about respecting each others different beliefs and cultures, respecting choices in play, showing respect by listening to one another and compromising where needed and through age appropriate text, recognising how we can sometimes offend people without meaning to.

We also thought about how important it is that we follow rules and how without each of us committing to school rules our community would not be a happy place to learn and play.

To further reinforce these lessons, we are going to introduce a 'Respect Wall' in the school. This display will showcase stories and examples of respectful behaviour observed within our school community. We would really like to have examples of children demonstrating respect outside of schools, so please email in or send your child into school with a note, photo or similar that we can add to our display.
